

TB Screening – Procedure to Check the TB Screening Status of Patients May 21, 2024

- 1. Pull PROMIS TB Screening Tracking Report:
 - Go to Reports, TB Screening Tracking Report.
 - Enter the dates of interest (based on start date of chronic dialysis), dialysis type and dialysis or primary management centre.
 - Click on Run.
- 2. Go to the "BCCDC alerted" column on the TB Screening Tracking Report (far right-hand column). Click on the down arrow so that patients with incomplete TB screening are shown at the top of the report.



Follow this process for each patient where the "BCCDC alerted" column is blank.

1. Go to Renal > TB Services > TB Assessment. A table under TB Screening Questionnaire Summary will appear.



- 2. If the TB Screening Questionnaire Summary is blank, TB screening has not been started. Proceed with TB testing.
- 3. If the TB Screening Questionnaire Summary is partially complete, *TB screening has been initiated but may not have been completed*. Click anywhere in the row to open the patient's TB Screening Questionnaire detail page.
- 4. If the TB assessment, chest x-ray or IGRA is blank, complete the one(s) that is missing and enter the date(s) into PROMIS.
 - Do not create a new assessment.
 - Do not repeat the chest x-ray or IGRA if done previously even if long ago (e.g., 2 years ago).
 - Once all 3 components are completed, PROMIS will automatically notify BCCDC.
- 5. If the TB assessment, chest x-ray and IGRA have been completed but the BCCDC Alerted Date/Time is blank, re-save the record. This will notify BCCDC that the results are ready for review. (Note: after July 2023, BCCDC is automatically notified once the TB assessment, chest x-ray and IGRA have been completed). Check that the Alert to BCCDC date has been updated.

- 6. Re-run the PROMIS TB Screening Tracking Report and check that the above update has resulted in completion of the "BCCDC alerted" column.

Notes about TB Screening:

- 1. Patients previously screened using the BCCDC/BCR screening process (questionnaire, IGRA and chest x-ray) do not need to be rescreened. This includes patients changing treatment types (e.g., PD to HD) or changing HD units (e.g., in-centre to community; KCC to HD). To view the TB physician narrative report: Go to Documents, filter by TB Services Recommendation.
