The BC Renal Executive Committee provides a forum for the discussion of strategic directions for kidney care provision at the provincial and health authority renal program levels to ensure delivery of kidney services is consistent across the province, and to find solutions to significant issues. The committee serves to enhance strategic decision making, efficiency and effectiveness, planning, and effective internal and external communication

Members of the committee include patient partners, clinical and administrative leaders from provincial and regional health authorities, BC Renal, BC Transplant, Provincial Health Services Authority and the Kidney Foundation—BC & Yukon Branch. Members work together by sharing their perspectives to enhance strategic decision making, efficiency and effectiveness, planning, and effective internal and external communications for quality person- and family-centred kidney care.

<u>Collaborate</u>: BC Renal will work together with all members in decision making, developing alternatives and solutions, and will include your recommendations into each decision as much as possible.

- People with lived experience of chronic kidney disease in BC
- Current or previous experience of being a member of a BC Renal committee or working group
- Experience working and sharing perspectives with diverse groups of people
- A strong interest in partnering and working together with health professionals to advance quality person- and family-centred kidney care
